Fasting is limiting yourself to one full meal a day. Other meals during the day should not equal the one full meal. Restraining from unnecessary food should be exercised. Fasting is required, especially on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday for those between the ages of 18 and 59.

ABSTINANCE

Abstinence is refraining from meat and expensive foods on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays in Lent, as well as giving up a favorite food for the good of a deprived person.
