The closing date to register for the Mass is Friday, May 15th by 5:00pm



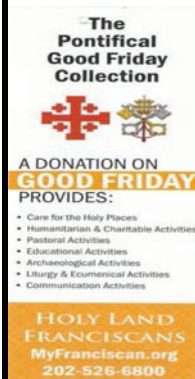

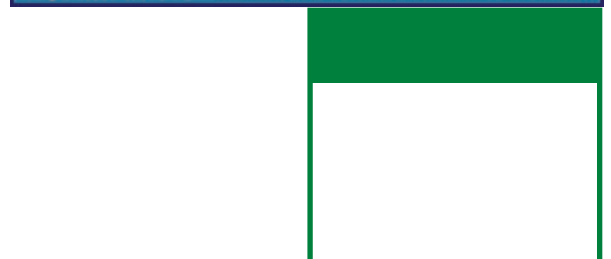

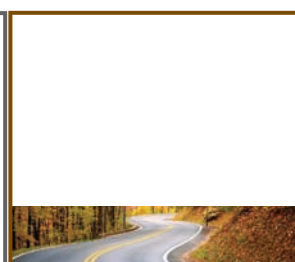
