*All are cordially invited to join with us in prayer.*

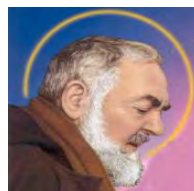

### FOOD PANTRY

Now that the Franciscan Sisters have discontinued their food pantry, we would like to continue with supporting a local parish. Helping Hands is part of a parish ministry to the poor and homeless. The parish is Immaculate Conception Church, 754 East Gun Hill Rd, made up of mostly poor people coming from different countries (African Americans, Latino, Asians and some from the Middle Eastern Countries). They serve a hot meal five days a week, average per day 200 people (in summer 380 to 400 people).

Each month they provide food items in bags to households in need around 300 families. They rely on the food donation of various organizations. Many elderly people come regularly for a meal. A significant number of unemployed and homeless come daily for the food. They also get a large number of children when the schools are closed.
